The SAFP Family Development program, cornerstone of all the work that we've done since our beginnings in 1965, offers a special kind of magic in knowing that a particular family in India is receiving your direct support. This special connection means journeying with your partner family over the years as their lives are transformed through occasional letters, photos, and often a Christmas card.

Ensuring that your partner family's greetings, written in a remote village, thousands of miles across the ocean, arrives at your doorstep is no easy feat. The challenges of poverty requires that families work long hours daily, attending to family obligations and ensuring food is on the table, leaving very few opportunities for other tasks. High illiteracy rates mean having to rely on field staff to physically write down, translate, and then type letters being dictated. Reaching the homes of most partner families requires traveling vast distances for field staff with their cameras in tow, often over rough terrain on unreliable and crowded public transportation, and during extreme weather conditions of high heat or monsoon rains.

Over the last two years, due to the pandemic, there have been incredible hurdles for our field staff to simply to meet face-to-face with families, and the mail service has been disrupted to a degree that is difficult to measure. We understand the disappointment and concern some of you have

experienced in not hearing regularly from your partner families. It's been a difficult time and it can feel painful to be cut off from the people we care about, especially when we are so far apart.

We have received the good news from our colleagues in the SAFP India office that things are slowly starting to return to a sense of normalcy, even though dire after-effects of the pandemic continue to affect people in India. Bishop Sebastian gave us the wonderful news that Field Coordinators are now able to resume their normal schedule of visits, catching up with families face-to-face after years of often only-remote communications. They are doing their all to ensure that communications will continue.

We are delighted to share with you that mail from India is expected to start arriving more regularly. Hopefully by the end of 2022, you will once again start to see the flow of stories, pictures, and messages that you have enjoyed in years past.

Thank you for your patience and understanding. Despite the challenges and hurdles over the past few years, we are excited to think about those bonds of caring and friendship starting to renew and grow again in 2023.



Although communications have been disrupted between most partner families since mid-2020, our operations in Canada and India have continued all throughout that time. Please be assured that we continue to appreciate your generous support and we remain as grateful as ever!
